Financial Timeline and Update

Unlike household budgets, our fiscal year begins in July. This means that at the start of the calendar year in January, when households are preparing for their annual tax report, we are at the midpoint of our financial year and beginning to strategize and plan for the next year.

To stay proactive and purposeful about our finances, Big Spring School District follows a rigorous financial process. There are checks and balances along the way to ensure resident tax dollars are being invested wisely and for the purpose of educating our students.

In November, the board adopted a resolution not to exceed the Act 1 index. In December, the Finance Committee met to review the prior year and take a first look at the next year's budget.

The remainder of the timeline includes:

- January-February 2024 Review and revision of department budgets
- March 2024 Finance Committee Meeting to review department budgets
- April 2024 Finance Committee Meeting to review the proposed final budget
- June 2024 Finance Committee Meeting to review final budget
- June 2024 The Board to adopt the final budget
