Fighting childhood hunger in the Big Spring School District

The PAW Packs Program is a community service whose mission is to provide supplemental weekend food to children in the Big Spring School District. The children who are available for the program are identified by the district.

In the United States one in five children goes hungry and it is one of the prominent obstacles in hindering a child's learning progress. This program is run entirely by volunteers from the community and provides these children with weekend bags of food during the school year and monthly boxes of food over the summer months.

With the expansion of our services, we have begun a PAW Packs Sponsorship Program, wherein businesses, churches, and community members are able to support a school district child for the 2017-2018 school year and summer months. The cost is \$360.00 per year. This will provide a child with a bag of food each weekend during the school year plus additional food over the summer vacation. Sponsorship payments can be made monthly, quarterly, or yearly. Sponsorship is tax deductible; receipts will be mailed to sponsors after each payment.
